BATTLE CARDS (1993) Merlin Collection. This fantasy art set was designed to be played as a game between two players. Each card has “scratch-off” places around the border which reveal certain symbols for play. The fronts have a bordered illustration with the scratch-off areas, the backs have story text and information. The base set is divided into subsets titled “The History of Vangoria”, “Artists of Vangoria”, “The Quests of Vangoria”, “The Darklands”, “Magic Spells”, “Barbarian Territories”, “Zittonia”, “Advanced Combat Cards”, “Quaine”, “Constantia”, and “Secrets of Vangoria”.

BATTLEFIELD EARTH (MORE THAN): THE SCIENCE FICTION ART OF L. RON HUBBARD (1995) Comic Images. This is a set that focuses on the artwork featured on covers of novels written by science fiction author L. Ron Hubbard, plus some pulp fiction magazines covers from issues that contain his works. Cards 13 and 24 form a 2-card puzzle image; cards 34, 38, and 43 form a 3-card puzzle image.

BATTLEFIELD EARTH (2000) Upper Deck. Based on the science-fiction movie with photo images taken from the film. Most of the fronts show a single image, and most of the backs have a portion of the front image along with story narrative. Some fronts have two images. The base set is made up the subsets titled “The Story”, “The Cast”, “Gallery”, and “Behind the Scenes”. The subset “Gallery” features production art. Distributed in hobby and retail packs.
